- Poster-Only

- To prepare, make sure you:
 - Have practised explaining your poster concisely
 - Are ready to answer questions and engage with interested attendees.

Poster Specifications

- Printed A0, portrait poster (841 x 1189 mm) to be displayed during the 2025ARSC
- You may use your own or your organisation's style
- Structure and Layout
 - Title: Clear, concise, and readable (80-100 pt)
 - Brevity: Use bullet points and short sentences
 - Clarity: Avoid jargon; make your content accessible to a general audience.
 - Key Messages: Highlight main findings and implications
 - Proofreading: Review for typos, consistency, and seek feedback before finalising

PREPARING YOUR POSTER

Presentation Tips (for 3-minute presentations only)

- You may use powerpoint slides
- Use landscape orientation (standard or 16:9 ratio)

Recommendations:

- Maximum of 3 slides only
- Use images from your poster so attendees know what to look for at the poster display
- · Practice with a timer
- Speak slowly and clearly
- Focus on the highlights
 - You don't need to cover every detail
 - Interested attendees can follow up with you after your presentation.
